

Amazon FAQ

- (1) If you're using your Amazon Kindle's Wifi to borrow...
 - a. Register your Kindle with an Amazon account, using Kindle's Wifi (please note: if you purchase your Kindle from somewhere other than Amazon.com, you must have access to Wifi to register; it is done directly through your Kindle)
 - b. On your computer, go online to Mid York's MYLibrary2go (<http://midyork.lib.overdrive.com>), and check out Kindle book
 - i. When done, click on "Get for Kindle" link
 - ii. This will take you to Amazon page, with an option to "Get library book" and tell it to deliver to "---'s Kindle"
 - c. On your Kindle (with WiFi), sync and the library book will display on your Kindle
 - d. On your computer, to manage your library book(s):
 - i. Go to your Amazon account page and select "Manage your Kindle" which launches "Your Kindle Library"
 - ii. Under the actions button, you can return, delete, transfer, and send to any Amazon app.
 - iii. When you return an item, you will receive an email from Amazon letting you know your lending period is up, and gives a link to buy the book.
 - e. Your Kindle will show a [Loan ended] next to the title, and you will want to click left on the notice, and select "remove from device."

- (2) If borrowing and transferring from your computer to Kindle (with no Wifi)....
 - a. You must register your Kindle, which requires that your Kindle have WiFi access
 - b. On your computer, go online to Mid York's MYLibrary2go, and check out kindle book
 - i. When done, click on "Get for Kindle" link
 - ii. Make sure that your kindle is connected
 - iii. This will take you to Amazon page, with an option to "Get library book" and tell it to deliver to computer
 - iv. The next option is to deliver to "---'s Kindle", and will then take you to a screen to save the file.
 - v. Once it is saved, go to where your downloads save and right click and copy the file
 - vi. Then go to your Kindle file on the computer, and double click on the folder "Documents." Right click and past the book.
 - c. It is now on your Kindle.
